- Those applicants who do not have a High School diploma or GED must take and pass the Comprehensive Adult Student Assessment Systems (CASAS) test.

Building Construction

Stockton Center

You will learn carpentry, plumbing, electrical, and other general construction trades. Classes are taught by industry professionals through hybrid training which includes computer trainings and instructor led, in-person and shop classes.

You will earn:

- *Multi-Craft Core Curriculum (MC3) certification;*
- *First-Aid/CPR/AED certificate;*
- *OSHA 10 Safety Certificate; and*
- *Hands-on training through assisting Habitat for Humanity of San Joaquin County building houses for low-income families in Stockton and the practices of remodel and building renovations.*

This course is 660 hours. Training days are Mon – Friday, 7am to 3pm. Upon successful completion of the program, you will receive a MC3 certificate and a certificate of completion and introduction to trades unions and construction companies for employment. Commercial Truck Driving

Santa Rosa, Olivehurst Stockton Centers

The commercial truck driving trainees will study with their instructor to be able to take and pass the State of California Dept. of Motor Vehicles Class A Driving Permit. Upon the appropriate amount of behind-the-wheel training time, and upon the approval of the instructor, the permit holder will be able to schedule and take the DMV driving test to become a licensed Class A driver.

This course is 300 hours. Training days are Mon – Friday, 7am to 3pm. Upon successful completion of the program, the trainee will receive a certificate of completion. There are presently many trucking companies that are ready to hire graduates of CHD.

Welding

Stockton and Olivehurst Centers

In this 660-hour welding course you will learn how to weld. Training days are Mon – Friday, 7am to 3pm. The instruction you receive will prepare you for the certification tests in:

- *Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW);*
- *Gas Metal Arc Welding (GMAW);*
Option A:
- *Gas Tungsten Arc Welding (GTAW);*
Option B:
- *Fluxcored Arc Welding (FCAW).*
- *Blueprint reading*
- *Gas Cutting and Welding*
- *Multi-Craft Core Curriculum (MC3) certification; First-Aid/ CPR/AED certificate; OSHA 10 Safety Certificate;*

This course will prepare you to pass the American Welding Society (AWS) Certification Testing to become a certified welder.
