COURSES OFFERED

- Welding
 - Our program includes instruction in trade tools, shop equipment, welding, thermal cutting, metallurgy, pattern development, fabrication, testing, inspection, shipment preparation, and fabrication installation.
- Building Construction
 - Students learn basic construction skills, hands-on learning in tool and equipment safety, cost- and time-estimating, blueprint reading, and basic skills in carpentry, plumbing, and electrical.
- Truck Driving
 - This program provides students with the technical knowledge, theory, and behind-the-wheel skills necessary to operate and maneuver a Commercial Class A tractor-trailer in the United States and abroad.
